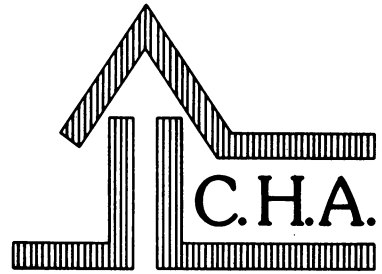

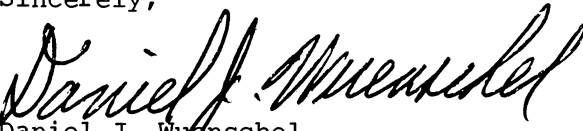
Dear Mr. Sullivan:

The following is in answer to your request and Councillor Sullivan's order of May 21st regarding the court matter between the Cambridge Housing Authority and Francis White.

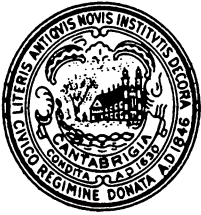

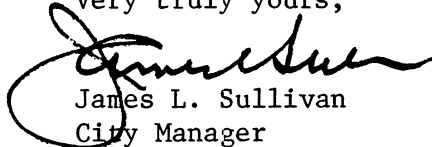
