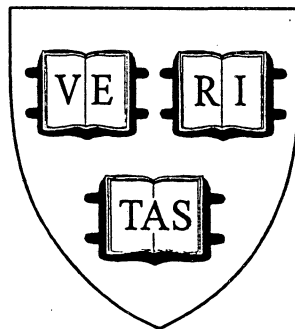

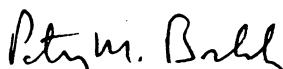
Dear Mayor Duchay:
