Michael J. Mahoney served as a Court Officer in the Middlesex Probate Court during which time his wise counsel was respected by attorneys and all others who came in contact with him in this capacity prior to his retirement in October 1962, and

Michael J. Mahoney continued his active interest in civic affairs and gave freely of his time without compensation as a member of the Cambridge Water Board up to the date of his death, therefore be it
