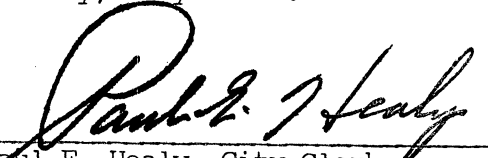
MAYOR RUSSELL

- WHEREAS: This City Council wishes to recognize and commend exemplary performance by members of the Cambridge Police Department; and
- WHEREAS: In the early morning hours of May 1, 1984 Patrol Officers Francis Corcoran and Robert Cloran responded to an armed robbery on Cogswell Avenue and, after interviewing the victim, immediately broadcast a description of the suspects and their automobile; and
- WHEREAS: Due to the quick response of Officers Corcoran and Cloran, the suspect vehicle was spotted, followed, and subsequently stopped a short time later; and
- WHEREAS: During the ensuing questioning of occupants of the suspect vehicle, Officers Corcoran and Cloran each observed handguns protruding from under the front driver and passenger seats; and
- WHEREAS: The suspects were successfully removed from the vehicle without incident and a subsequent search produced an amount of stolen property from that morning's robbery and several previously unsolved robberies; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council do hereby congratulate and commend Patrol Officers Francis Corcoran and Robert Cloran for their prompt response, keen powers of observation, and calmness in a dangerous situation concerning the events of May 1, 1984; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That a copy of this City Council resolution be made a part of their permanent record.
