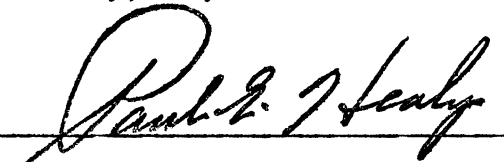
MAYOR DUEHAY

- WHEREAS: Several Cambridge residents have expressed concern over the absence of benches in the newly-opened, underground MBTA station; and
- WHEREAS: In the past, the MBTA has provided benches in this area for the use and convenience of MBTA travellers; and
- WHEREAS: Initial MBTA plans did not include the installation of benches for the renovated underground station; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager confer with MBTA officials concerning the possibility of installing benches at the various bus stops in the underground station in Harvard Square; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to this City Council within the next two weeks as to the status of this request.
