The Public Aid Committee reports, pursuant to the rules of the City Council, that it has obtained from the Secretary of the Board of Public Welfare and from the W.P.A. Sponsor, monthly reports for the month of November.

The Board of Public Welfare reports on Old Age Assistance cases, nineteen less than at the end of October, and on General Relief and Aid to Dependent Children Sixty-nine cases less than at the end of October. These classes of cases cost the city \$102,615.90, during the month of November, a decrease of \$9,624.39.

The Sponsor's Agent reports three hundred and ninety-six persons employed during the month of November on W.P.A. projects, a decrease of fifty-five from the previous month. The cost for November was \$370.90 to the City, a decrease of \$1,034.65 and \$28,333.92 to the Federal Government, an increase of \$604.92. Eighty-two persons were placed in private employment by the Municipal Employment Bureau, of whom 14 were from Welfare and 23 from W.P.A.
