- WHEREAS: On July 26, the Governor signed Chapter 200 of the Acts of 1988, "An Act Relative To Residential Classification Burdens," effective immediately; and
- WHEREAS: This Act amends the state property tax classification statute to allow municipalities to shift additional property tax burdens from residential to commercial taxpayers under certain circumstances; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager prepare a written analysis of the new Act's significance for the City of Cambridge, including any possible options to Act may present for the current fiscal year's tax bills, and report this analysis to the City Council as soon as possible.
