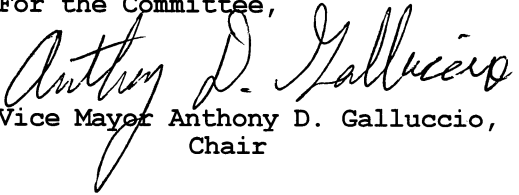

The Claims Committee conducted a public meeting on Wednesday, April 8, 1998 beginning at six o'clock and five minutes p. m. in the Ackermann Room, city Hall.
