1) Trees to be trimmed:

- a) In front of 29 & 31 Linnaean Street which are causing doorways to be dark;
- b) Tree at corner of Avon Hill and Linnaean Street, causing a dark corner;
- c) Tree near the corner of Raymond and Linnaean Street blocking light;
- d) Trees overhanging sidewalk at 77-77a Raymond Street;
- e) In front of 271 Upland Road near corner of Huron Avenue; and
- f) Around street lights on Linnaean Street.

2) Bushes in front of homes overhanging sidewalk:

- a) 25 Avon Street;
- b) 37 Linnaean Street; and
- c) 15 Raymond Street.

3) Lighting Problems:

- a) Gray Street, near the corner of Linnaean; Pole #8, Light is dim;
- b) Check lights on Linnaean Street which seem dim; Perhaps it needs re-lamping; and
- c) Only one light is working on the building in the rear of the Peabody School. the others are out. Same on both sides of the school, Avon Street and Walker Street.

4) Graffiti seems to be on the increase around the school and other sections of the neighborhood; now therefore be it


