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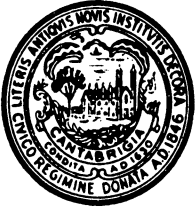

To the Honorable, the City Council:

In response to City Council Order No. 20 of March 9, 1987, City Engineer Joan Lastovica has contacted representatives of the Massachusetts Public Works Department (MDPW) for an update on the reconstruction of the bridge at Beacon Street and Somerville Avenue. Sketch plans are currently being revised to change the bridge profile to increase the clearance for transportation; these plans should be completed by the end of April 1987. Following review by the MDPW and the Federal Highway Administration (approximately June 1987), final plans will be readied for the bid process estimated for January 1988. Construction bids will be opened by March 1988 and the estimated completion date for the reconstruction project is December 1988. The bridge will be constructed in two phases to allow for traffic in one direction at all times. It should be noted, however, that the MDPW representatives cautioned that this is a very optimistic schedule for completion of this project.
