Maywood & others that Cropping Stones be placed across River at junction of Auburn St. — Of S. Pear & others for Cropping Stones be placed from Howard, across River St. — Of P. T. Clark & others that Cropping Stones be placed across Cambridge, on the Wisterly Side of Prospect St. also, that the Side walk on both sides of Cambridge St between Prospect St & Webster Avenue, may be properly graded, & put in safe Condition. — And of Saml Snow in behalf of many Citizens, that a Street Cropping may be laid across North Avenue from Wendell to Shepherd Street. have attended to the duty assigned them & would respectfully — Report —

That the lateness of the season, & want of sufficient Appropriations would prevent the work being accomplished this ~~same~~ year. they would therefore recommend the reference of the several Petitions to the next City Government for the Committee.
