- WHEREAS: Sister Mary St. Anne is a native of Cambridge graduating from local schools prior to her entering the convent in 1930; and
- WHEREAS: During her fifty years as a religious, Sister Mary St. Anne has served the Boston Archdiocese by teaching in several schools as a religious educator holding a total of three teaching assignments in her native city, two at St. Mary's School and one at the Blessed Sacrament School; and
- WHEREAS: At the present time Sister Mary St. Anne is employed as a part-time Assistant in the Recording Studio for the Massachusetts Association for the Blind along with being a volunteer tape reader an assignment she finds most fulfilling as it enables her to continue her apostolate in helping to educate those who suffer from visual handicaps; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere congratulations to Sister Mary St. Anne Mehigan S.N.D. as she celebrates her Golden Jubilee with a Mass of Thanksgiving on Sunday, May 18, 1980 at 2 p. m. at the Blessed Sacrament Church; and be it further
