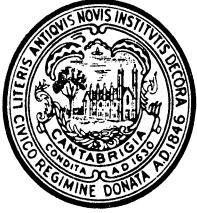

- June, 1977 - Present     Director, Elder Cooperative Housing Program - Cambridge, Ma.  
Main tasks: development of 3 and 4 bedroom apartments for former nursing home patients and those at risk of institutionalization. Other work includes lectures, program development and grantsmanship for other congregate housing programs in the State.
- March, 1976 - May, 1977     Research Assistant to Robert Goodman - Cambridge, Ma.  
Author of "After the Planners". Present lecturer at Stanford University.  
The areas I researched for Mr. Goodman's new book, entitled "Regions of Power: Beyond the Urban Crisis", included - the shifting use of state taxes, municipal financing, industrial development, manpower programs, and revenue sharing.
- Sept., 1974 - Sept., 1975     Commission on Economic Opportunity - Wilkes-Barre, Pa.  
Position title, Community Organizational Specialist. Main tasks involved organizing local groups around issues of housing, health care and drafting of alternative proposals for the use of community development funds. Major work was an investigation of 221 (d) 3 housing by the General Accounting Office. Other tasks included the development of a community newsletter, working with the outreach staff in developing a more efficient intake system and the implementation of the Sec. 8 housing and winterization programs. I had regular supervision of four staff members and prepared and submitted weekly progress reports to the Executive Director.

- May, 1973 - Sept., 1973     Research Assistant, Florence Heller School for Advanced Study in Social Welfare - Waltham, Ma.  
Study entitled: Intrametropolitan Migration, Public Finance and Property Values - A Socioeconomic Study of Boston 1870 - 1970  
The study was funded by the National Science Foundation and the Institute of Mental Health. The study examined the interrelationships between real estate values, public financing and intra-urban migration in the metropolitan area. Emphasis was placed on the process by which people, capital and jobs move from central city and inner ring communities to newer suburbs, leaving behind depressed areas around the central business district. I had the responsibility for the economic, political and social study of Somerville, Massachusetts, examining the impact of 100 years of in - out migration on city development.


