ORDERED: That the following transfer be made in the General Fund of the City of Cambridge:




To the Honorable, the City Council:

The attached appropriation transfer of \$5,345.00 from Salaries and Wages to Other Ordinary Maintenance is requested by the Arts Council to cover the cost of clerical assistance.

Earlier in the year the Council voted supplementary funds for a director and a clerk/typist; however, the work plans of the Arts Council call for paying of the clerical worker through a contract and not on the City's regular payroll.
