AMENDED ORDER

- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge is faced with an emerging crisis due to the increased cost of home heating fuel, the need for citizens to make cash payments, and the likelihood that many of our citizens will be unable to keep their homes warm this winter; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to set up an Emergency Fuel Fund which would be a revolving loan and grant program to be administered jointly and in partnership by a board consisting of the city government, the business community, the institutional community and the banking community; and be it further
- ORDERED: That he set down guidelines to assist needy families and individuals through loans or cash grants; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Council hereby requests the City Manager to make a cash appropriation in the amount of \$250,000 or a sum sufficient for an emergency fuel fund as the city's contribution to this fund and as a challenge to the other participants of the partnership in the hope that they will respond in kind; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report to this City Council how the four hundred dollar subsidy of the Federal Government for improved insulation in residences could be related to the subject matter of this order; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to provide the City Council with a carefully thought-out process or structure by which the efforts of public and private agencies could be coordinated.
