- WHEREAS: The Cambridge Rindge and Latin School Boys Cross-Country team has won yet another in a long string of track meets throughout the season, recently beating the rest of the Suburban League at the All Star meet at Franklin Park, placing first with 53 points; and
- WHEREAS: The jubilant crowd in attendance watched CRLS Captain David Brode with only five yards remaining overpower Brockton High's Captain Michael Woodman with a finishing time of 15.47; and
- WHEREAS: This was only one of several breathtaking events during the meet, another being Junior Lars Dietrich beating his own teammate Michael Brode, the first time during the season, an indication of how truly competitive this team really is and of the hard work put into this team by their coach Bob Maguire; and
- WHEREAS: Coach Maguire, although adamant on high performance and standards for all of the team, provides strength, support and leadership for them and truly believes in their ability, evidenced by a recent statement that "the tougher the course, the better the Cambridge teams run", this maxim holds true for both the Varsity and Junior Varsity teams; now therefore be it
