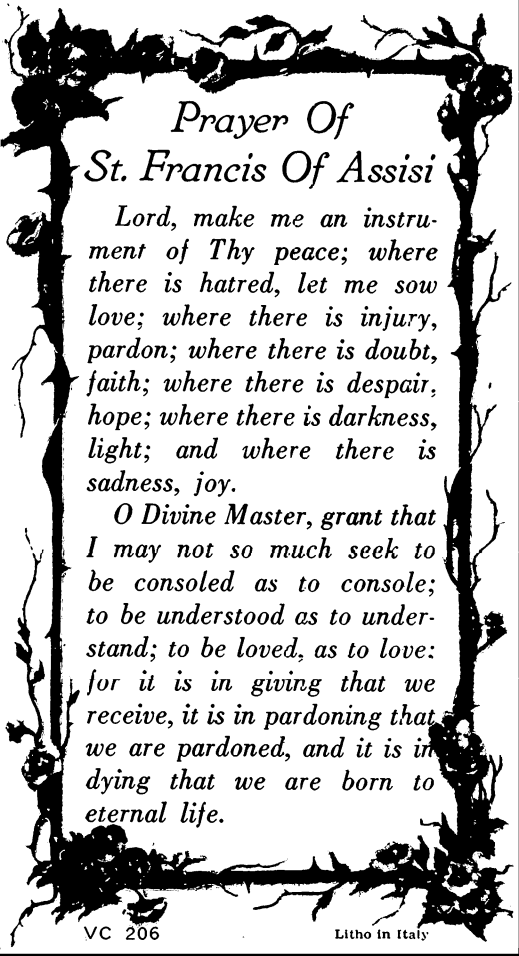

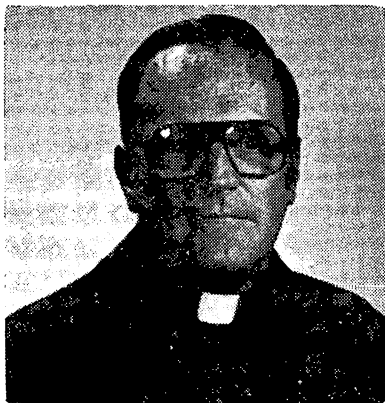
Thank You
