Estates benefitted to be assessed according to law.

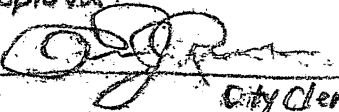

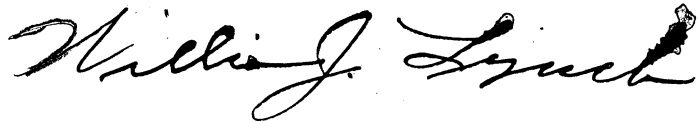
