Sir:

This corporation has purchased from Frederick D. Fisk, et al, Trustee, 36,000 square feet of land with a frontage of 250 feet on the Esplanade in Cambridge and is having plans drawn for the erection of a large office and laboratory building on this property for our own use.

The property is situated 550 feet east of Wadsworth Street and adjoins the land of Etta F. and W. A. Kendall. There is no sewer, water nor gas laid on this part of the Esplanade, only an electric light conduit.

We, therefore, respectfully petition the City Council of Cambridge to authorize and have constructed a sewage system for this section of the Esplanade at the earliest possible moment, and also to have the water and gas mains laid. Should the City Council require any further details as to location of the property, etc., we will be pleased to furnish them.

That common sewers be laid in the streets hereinafter named, the same to be built by contract or by the day, with, or without advertising for proposals therefor, at the option of the City Engineer, and the expense thereof to be charged to the appropriation for Sewers (Construction:—Sundry Sewers). Estates benefitted to be assessed according to law.

1. Wadsworth Street sewer extended to Charles River Road about 140 feet.
2. Charles River Road from Wadsworth Street easterly about 600 feet.

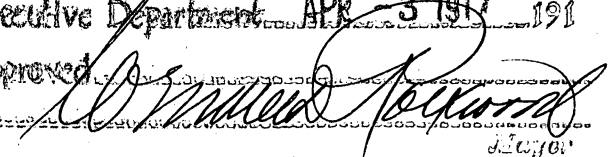

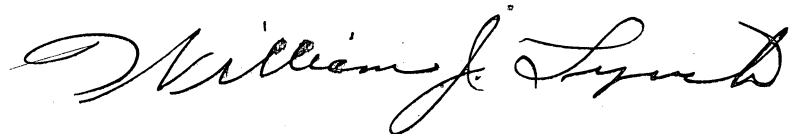
