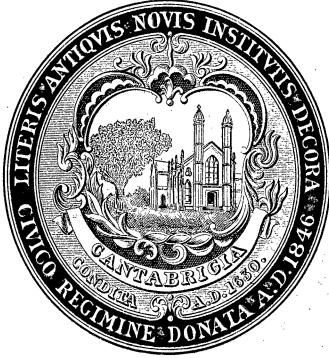

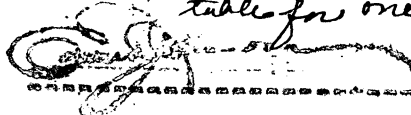
This proposed change also meets with the approval of the City Electrician.
