I would like to inform you that I will be calling a meeting of the City Manager, Superintendent of Schools, and chairs of the School Budget Committee and City Council Finance Committee, for the purpose of discussing areas of administration that could be brought together to save money. As you surely realize, the city faces fiscal constraints--regardless of whether or not Question 3 passes--and it is my hope that we can maintain important services by finding ways to economize through combining administrative and/or managerial functions. This is not a new idea, but one that we need to examine more closely as there may be cost-effective technological or collaborative measures.
