the said Respondent its officers, agents, ^{and} servants to enjoin and restrain
the said Respondent ^{and} the persons before named and each and every of them
from entering upon or taking possession of a certain strip of land twelve
feet in width, particularly described in said complaint as the entire
length or boundary of a certain tract of land situated in said Cambridge
between Harvard ^{and} Main Streets so called, extending 200 and ³⁸/₁₀₀ feet on
said Main Street as in said complaint is at large set out, or from in any
way disturbing or interfering with the quiet possession and enjoyment
of said Complainant over said strip of land, It is ordered, that the Complainant
notify the Respondent to appear before our said Court in Chambers, at the Court
House in Boston in the County of Suffolk on Tuesday the seventh day of April
next at three o'clock P.M. by causing an attested copy of this order to be
served upon said Respondent seven days at least before said last mentioned
day, that he may then and there show cause, if any there be why such
injunction should not be granted.
