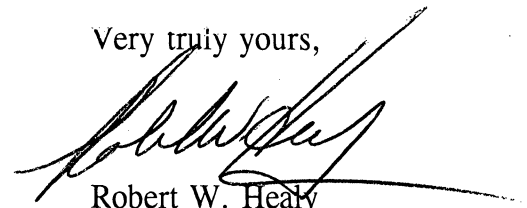
In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 44, regarding traffic safety on Concord Avenue, please be advised of the following:

The Traffic, Parking & Transportation Department has reviewed the signs and pavement markings along Concord Avenue between Alewife Brook Parkway and the Belmont Town Line. All the crosswalks and lane lines were repainted this September. The double yellow center line was painted this past Spring and will be repainted shortly. The crosswalk at Griswold Street will be crosshatched this Fall. There are several "Pedestrian Crossing" warning signs posted along this section, along with an advisory speed sign as one enters from the Town of Belmont. A similar warning sign will be installed for traffic entering from Alewife Brook Parkway.

With the painting of the center line and crosswalk and the installation of the warning sign near the Parkway, Traffic, Parking & Transportation Director Susan Clippinger believes Concord Avenue is adequately marked as a densely populated area.

In addition, Police Commissioner Perry Anderson reports that the Commanding Officer of the Day Patrol Section has been directed to have the Traffic Unit conduct selective enforcement on Concord Avenue between Huron Avenue and Fresh Pond Parkway during the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m.
