WHEREAS: James worked for the State of Massachusetts and for Waltham Fruit Company; and

WHEREAS: James was an active member of his community; he was a member of the Cambridge VFW Post 8818, the Holy Name Society of the Sacred Heart Church in Watertown, the Watertown 202 Club, the Sons of Italy in Watertown, and the Saint Lucy Club in Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: James also volunteered his services at the V.A. Hospital; now therefore be it
