On January 10, 1984, at our regularly scheduled meeting, members from the Boys and Girls Club met with neighborhood residents to present plans for their proposed renovation of St. Mary's Hall, as requested by the City Council at their meeting of December 19, 1983.

It was the consensus of the community that although we welcome the Boys and Girls Club in our neighborhood, the inclusion of "incubator space" at the facility is completely unacceptable.

This is a heavily impacted residential neighborhood. We view with alarm any use of the space in or adjacent to Sennott Park for any purpose other than recreation.

We look forward to meeting with the Boys and Girls Club in the future. Their willingness to make their facility open to neighborhood residents was welcome, and we sincerely hope that will be possible for us to work together toward common goals in the future.
