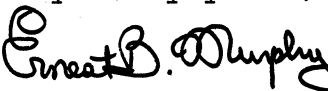

The undersigned respectfully prays

that she be reimbursed for the loss of her dentures while a patient at the Cambridge Hospital. She was taken to the hospital by ambulance on November 25, 1975 and was removed from the Cambridge Hospital to the Massachusetts Rehabilitation Hospital, 125 Nashua Street, Boston on December 18, 1975.

The loss of her dentures occurred shortly before she left the Cambridge Hospital. This will be confirmed by a reliable witness as she actually handed one of her dentures to the witness, requesting her to put it with the other denture on a dish provided by the nurse, and the fact that the dentures were missing at the time she was discharged from the hospital was well known to Dr. Kempner who was attending her at the time of her discharge and he has indicated that considerable time and effort was spent at that time to locate the dentures, without success.

Under these circumstances, it seems clear that the hospital should be liable at least for the cost of replacing the dentures. The work has just been completed by Dr. Norman W. Reinhalter, 5 Boylston Street, Cambridge, Massachusetts. His bill is attached hereto and your petitioner prays that she be reimbursed at least for the replacement of said dentures as indicated by said bill.
