To the Honorable, the City Council:

I have requested the Building Commissioner to conduct an investigation on the construction taking place at 107 Amory Street, in accordance with the Council Order of April 12, 1976.

The Building Commissioner has informed me that a valid and legal permit has been issued and is in conformance with the appropriate zoning requirements and building codes. A variance was granted in 1969 and the Building Commissioner has indicated that the architects are correcting a need under the present zoning for open space. The original Board of Appeals case has allowed them to build as they are currently doing.

With respect to the request of the Order to temporarily stop all construction, the Building Commissioner has advised that this would be impossible for the City would have no legal right to do so, since they are acting within the rules and regulations of the City in the construction.
