IN CITY COUNCIL

March 12, 1984

- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that its senior member, Alfred E. Vellucci, along with his wife Jurina will celebrate their Fiftieth Wedding Anniversary on Sunday, March 18, 1984 at a party sponsored in their honor by their children; and
- WHEREAS: Al and Jurina were married on March 19, 1934 and began a long and eventful marriage which blessed them with eight children who, in turn, gave Al and Jurina twenty-six grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren, all of whom look to them for not only love and affection, but guidance and leadership in helping each of them form their own lives and family; and
- WHEREAS: Politics to Al is as much a part of his life as his daily bowl of spaghetti or Jurina's regular trip to the bingo parlors, entering the political arena many years ago, when he ran successfully for the Democratic City Committee and served as a Delegate to the State Convention in Springfield, Massachusetts, at the age of twenty-one; and
- WHEREAS: Al ran for and was elected to the Cambridge School Committee in 1952, serving two terms, and in 1956 was elected to the City Council and has been re-elected fourteen consecutive times by the people of Cambridge, and has had the high honor of being selected by his colleagues in government to serve as Mayor and Chairman of the School Committee three times, during the years 1970-71, 1976-77 and most recently during the 1982-83 Council term; and
- WHEREAS: This political "bug" has not only deeply bitten Al, but it has also infected his son Peter, who, in 1983 was elected to serve the Twenty-sixth Middlesex District in the Massachusetts House of Representatives; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its most sincere congratulations and best wishes to Al and Jurina Vellucci on this happy occasion as they join with their family and friends to celebrate the Fiftieth Anniversary of their marriage, and to further wish them much health and happiness in the future years ahead; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare for presentation a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution on behalf of the entire City Council.
