School.

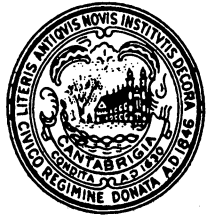


