

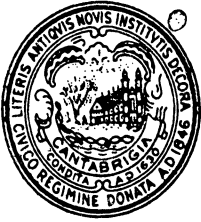

IN CITY COUNCIL

ORDERED:

That in accordance with the provisions of the General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge, Chapter Three, Section 3-2, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to William P. Kostopoulos, doing business as The Kendall Shop for the purpose of conducting a display of merchandise to be held every day with the exception of the winter months between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m., commencing immediately and running through the spring, summer and fall seasons at the premises numbered 242 Main Street, for the purpose of displaying and selling merchandise on the sidewalk at said premises, provided that no such permit shall be granted to exceed more than twenty-five percent of the width of the sidewalk from the property line of the premises in front of which said display shall be installed and provided further that before erecting the above named display, the petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.), conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said display.

Dear Mr. Kostopoulos:

With reference to your recent request for permission to display merchandise on the sidewalk in front of the above premises, permission is herewith granted subject to the following conditions:

Display and/or sale of merchandise is to be held every day, Mondays through Saturdays, from 8:30 A.M. to 5:30 P.M., until September 30, 1984.

No more than 3 feet or 25% of the sidewalk area, whichever is less, shall be occupied by the display.

You are requested to contact the Public Works Department for the appropriate sidewalk permit. The enclosed bond is to be executed and filed with the City Clerk's Office.

That in accordance with the provisions of the General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge, Chapter 3, Section 3-2, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to William P. Kostopoulos, doing business as Kendall Square Shoe Repair, for the purpose of displaying and selling merchandise on the sidewalk in front of the premises numbered 242 Main Street provided that no such permit shall be granted to exceed more than twenty-five per cent of the width of the sidewalk from the property line of the premises in front of which said display shall be installed and providing further that before erecting the above named display, the petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said display.

is hereby authorized to occupy for more than ten minutes at a time a space not exceeding *5*

feet in length by *25% of width* feet in width of the Sidewalk and to Sell Goods on the Sidewalk

in front of No. *242 Main St*

This authority however, is given to and accepted by the said licensee upon these express conditions: That the said licensee shall conform to the statutes and ordinances of the City and the regulations of the Public Works Department relating thereto, in force, and that may hereafter be in force, and to the specifications in the license; that any stand, shelf or other obstruction erected under this license shall be of a temporary character and shall be removed and the sidewalk left entirely clear at the close of business every night; that the licensee shall keep the street within fifty feet of his premises clean and free from all refuse matter or litter created by the sale or handling of his wares; that this license shall at all times be kept on the premises and be produced when demanded by any authorized person for inspection; that the licensee shall be responsible for any damage which may occur by reason of the occupancy or use of said Sidewalk under this license; that this license may be revoked at any time by the Commissioner of Public Works.
