ORDERED: That the plaza currently being constructed in Brattle Square in front of 21-33 Brattle Street, which is scheduled for completion in September of 1983, be hereinafter named "The Honorable Joseph A. DeGuglielmo Plaza" and that a commemorative stone be placed in the same signifying the the same at the expense of the family and friends of Joseph A. DeGuglielmo.
