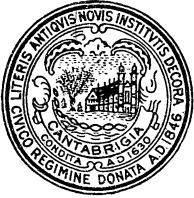

I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$61.93 to reimburse Paul Qualey, an employee of the Public Works Department for damages in this amount.

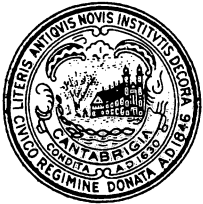
The Law Department, under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 100-A, defended an action against Paul Qualey in which there was a judgment of \$61.93.


