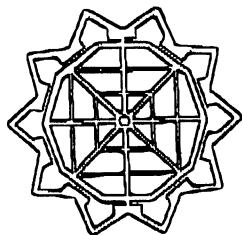

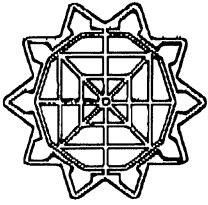

Governor Will Veto \$90M in Chapter 70 Funds

Call Your Legislators and Ask Them to Override the Veto

DATE: NOVEMBER 15, 1999

The MMA has learned that Governor Cellucci has made a final decision to veto the additional \$90 million in Chapter 70 aid that was included in the budget that the Legislature sent to him last Wednesday!

According to the best information we have, the Governor will submit his veto recommendations to the Legislature sometime tomorrow. This means that the Legislature will have one day -- until midnight Wednesday, November 17 -- to override the veto.

Please call your Legislators today and ask for their commitment to support efforts in both the House and Senate to take up the Chapter 70 veto, and ask for their commitment to override the Governor's veto of these important funds.

In addition please call the Governor's Office (617-727-9173) and register your strong opposition to the Governor's impending veto.

Time is of the essence. The Legislature will need to act on the veto before Wednesday at midnight, as there is little likelihood that the Legislature will return to formal sessions before the end of the year. Please call your Legislators today.
