We the undersigned residents of the Pleasant and Allston Sts. area hereby petition the City of Cambridge to remove the "No Standing Zone" from Pleasant Street at Alberico Park.

Removing these 6-8 parking spaces not only clears the path for Allston Street Stop sign violators to race through the intersection due to increased Pleasant Street visibility, but also severely increases an already heightened parking problem in the neighborhood, one that will magnify during the snow season.
