- WHEREAS: TEAM/USA, the sponsor, is a National amateur youth soccer organization designed to enable young athletes to acquire the capability of reaching Olympic calibre; and
- WHEREAS: These young people have an opportunity to be ambassadors for our City as well as our State; and
- WHEREAS: They need to obtain moral and financial support for themselves and their teams to be able to participate; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council commends and congratulates Stephanie Crayton, Maureen Kennedy, and Felix Massillon on their selection for youth soccer teams that will play in major tournaments throughout Europe; and be it further
