Councilors:

Because the time allowed for public comment was reduced at your last meeting, I was not afforded a reasonable opportunity to address the above matter or respond to unfair comments challenging my veracity that were made by a councilor who repeatedly interrupted the public's commentary.

Several distortions and misstatements of fact by the petitioner's attorney have apparently been accepted at face value by some members of the City Council, despite documentary evidence to the contrary.
