The Mayor and City Manager recently participated in ceremonies as the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority signed a contract with R. M. Bradley & Co., Inc. for land marketing and real estate development services for 24 acres of land in the Kendall Square urban renewal project, and

WHEREAS:

The Bradley firm, Boston and Cambridge-based and internationally recognized as a leader in real estate marketing, will be making initial contacts with prospective developers in order for Cambridge to be ready to proceed when the environmental impact study now underway is completed and approved by Federal and State officials, therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That this City Council go on record congratulating all parties concerned in taking this progressive step, and be it further

RESOLVED:
