Whereas the accompanying memorandum from Captain Lawrence Ferazani of the Cambridge Fire Department indicates that extremely dangerous fire and safety conditions exist at the Border Cafe in Harvard Square;

Whereas the accompanying decision to suspend the Border Cafe's license for three days has been made by the Cambridge License Commission;

Whereas the Cambridge Inspectional Services Department has received complaints concerning the emission of wood smoke from that restaurant's chimney which may be a violation of the city's ordinance;

Resolved that the City Council go on record in favor of vigorous follow-up inspections of the Border Cafe on an on-going basis to ensure that it meets fire, safety and emission codes at all times;

Further resolved that the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the License Commission, in order to protect the public against serious fire and life safety hazards, to report to him and to the City Council that all precautions have been taken to correct all conditions reported by the fire and inspectional services departments;

Further resolved that the City Council express its concern to the Border Cafe's landlord, Harvard University, that there are life safety issues present at that location for which the landlord bears ultimate responsibility and that the City Council urges Harvard University to require its tenant, the Border Cafe, to conform to all city codes and regulations to the letter.
