

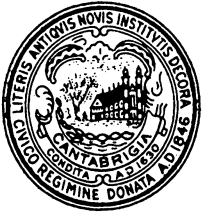
The progress on Cambridge's City Spirit project is very exciting and the Dayton Hudson Foundation is pleased to be involved with you in this worthwhile effort.


