Allan Doo, at 45, chef and restaurant owner

Allan Doo of Cambridge, a gourmet chef and restaurant owner, died Wednesday at Mt. Auburn Hospital in Cambridge after a brief illness. He was 45.

Born in Boston, he lived in Cambridge, where he attended Cambridge schools and remained a 40-year resident.

Mr. Doo attended Georgetown University, American Graduate School of International Management, and received his master's degree at New York University.

Mr. Doo owned the Cafe SoHo in Cambridge, and Bo-Bo restau-

rants in Somerville and Malden.

Mr. Doo is survived by his wife, Rose (Wong), two sons, Justin and Jason; his parents, Burton and Theresa (Fogar), all of Cambridge, and a brother, Stephen of Charlestown; several aunts, uncles and cousins.

A funeral service will be held at 11 a.m. today at the Celestial Chapel, J.S. Waterman & Sons Eastman-Waring.

Burial will be in Mt. Auburn Cemetery, Cambridge.
