WHEREAS: Many families with young children patronize the Strawberries store on Memorial for the purpose of renting videos or buying music tapes or CD's; and

WHEREAS: Recent or current window displays and displays at the counter feature "Adult Entertainment" videos with sexually explicit photos, illustrations, and captions; and

WHEREAS: This is disturbing to many parents and does not fit the image of a store which wishes to have broad appeal in the community; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council make known to the managers and owners of Strawberries that while we recognize the rights allowed to free expression under the First Amendment, we request that the owners and managers be mindful that their store serves children and teenagers for whom "Adult Entertainment" is not appropriate, and that they take steps to see that such items are not displayed in parts of the store accessible to children.
