RE: CENTRAL SQUARE ACTION PLAN

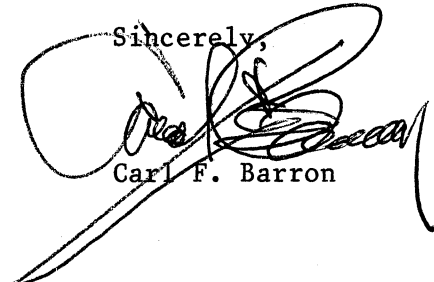
Dear Mr. Connaughton:
