Blake Manufacturing Company, - on the west side of Third Street, and next north of Binney Street, - be changed to a point on the same side of the street, twenty-five ^{feet} southwardly; and that the New England Telephone and Telegraph Company of Massachusetts, be requested to move said pole in accordance with the provisions of this order.
