**COUNCILLOR SULLIVAN**

**WHEREAS:** The recent severe winter weather with its heavy storms has demonstrated the need for a new approach to the problem of clearing sidewalks in the business and residential areas of Cambridge, and

**WHEREAS:** The medical profession, in numerous newspaper articles, urged Cambridge residents, who are forty-five and over, to refrain from shovelling snow in order to prevent serious medical damage due to overexertion caused by unusual physical activity, therefore be it

**ORDERED:** That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to develop a plan for the removal of sidewalk snow by:

1. the use of sidewalk plows in designated districts of the city on a priority basis; and
2. providing a list of high school students who will be available for snow removal; and
3. providing one communication center to coordinate sidewalk snow removal with appropriate advertising through radio and newspapers.
