ORDERED:•

That the order adopted by the City Council on September 10, 1951 providing that pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 28, Regulation of Traffic, Article III, Section 4, Location of bus stops, trackless trolley stops, taxicab stands and service zones, the Metropolitan Transit Authority was granted permission to re-locate the present inbound trackless trolley stop on Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge near Sullivan Square as follows -

The present southeasterly post to be placed on the northwesterly side of the driveway at #1038 Massachusetts Avenue and the present northwesterly post to be placed at the southeasterly side of the crosswalk opposite #1045 Massachusetts Avenue
