This is in acknowledgment of the Resolution adopted by the City Council on March 5, 1973 favoring the passage of H.R. 3354 and S. 679.

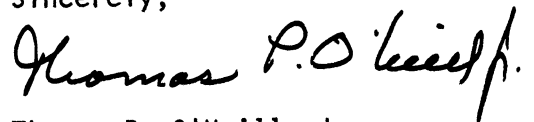
As you know the Senate passed a measure on March 15, 1973, permitting monies from the Highway Trust Fund to be used for rail and bus facilities as well as highways. I supported the House Efforts during the 92nd Congress, in both the Rules Committee and on the floor of the House, to "open up" the Highway Trust Fund for mass transit purposes and I will do so again in the 93rd Congress.

This is an especially crucial matter with regard to pollution and traffic as increased use of mass transit by our urban citizens would reduce pollution and congestion.
