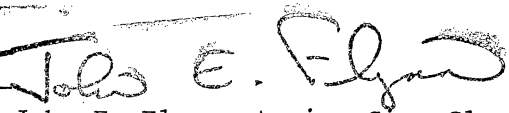

- WHEREAS: In the boom of development, it is especially critical that the City have an open space plan that assures space for recreation and breathing room remain in all of the neighborhoods; and
- WHEREAS: Recently we already saw an example, in the King School area, of conflict between critical open housing needs and open space needs; and
- WHEREAS: An inventory of the City's existing open space was completed last year - the first step necessary for developing a plan; therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager is hereby requested to initiate the development of a complete open space plan, including recommendations for any purchase or selling off of open space, as required by the needs of specific neighborhoods; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager include in his forthcoming budget any funds necessary to complete this project.
