

To the Honorable, the City Council:

As I informed the City Council last spring, I am now recommending a supplementary appropriation to the Finance Department to cover the costs of the completion of the property valuation project. The appropriation request is broken out as follows:

\$ 45,000	Completion of Commercial & Industrial Values..
15,000	Commercial and Industrial Impact Hearings
<u>35,000</u>	FY 1984 Data Processing Costs
\$ 95,000	

Background: To date, the City has expended \$154,000 to the company retained to value the City's Commercial and industrial properties. This appropriation will bring that total to approximately \$214,000. While this is the final appropriation request regarding the initial certification of the City's property values, the City Council should understand that we must now begin to maintain our new assessment list.
