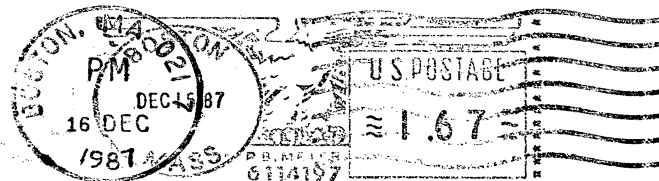

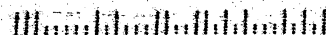

Please find enclosed an Order of Notice issued by the Department of Public Utilities with respect to a public hearing which the Department has scheduled for January 6, 1988 at 7:30 P.M.

The subject of the hearing is a petition by Boston Edison Company for an exemption from the operation of the Zoning Code of the City of Boston and the Zoning Ordinances of the City of Cambridge of four parcels of land (three located in Boston and one located partially in Boston and partially in Cambridge) in order to construct an underground transmission line between the Company's Mystic Generating Station in Everett and a substation it owns on Kingston Street in downtown Boston. Since this line is underground, the construction activities will involve trench work in the exempted parcel.

ORDER OF NOTICE

Petition of Boston Edison Company under the provisions of G.L. c. 40A, Sec. 3 for the exemption of certain premises, underground lines and equipment from the operation of the Zoning Code of the City of Boston and the Zoning Ordinances of the City of Cambridge.

Upon the foregoing petition, the Department of Public Utilities will conduct a public hearing on Wednesday, January 6, 1988 at 7:30 p.m. at Gardner Auditorium, State House, Boston, Massachusetts.

The Petitioner, Boston Edison Company, is required to give notice of said hearing by publication twice hereof, once at least fourteen (14) days and once at least seven (7) days prior to said date in the Boston Herald, the Boston Globe and the Cambridge Chronicle; to serve a copy hereof by registered mail at least fourteen (14) days prior to said date on the Mayor, the City Clerk the Chairman of the Planning Board, and the Chairman of the Board of Selectmen of said cities of Boston and Cambridge, the Chairmen of the Planning Boards of the cities of Quincy, Newton and Somerville and the towns of Milton, Dedham, Canton, Dedham, Brookline, Belmont, Watertown and Lexington and on all persons owning real estate abutting the lands hereinabove referred to, as determined by the last preceding assessment for taxation, and on all persons across a public way and all persons within 300 feet, and to make return of service and publication at the time of hearing.
