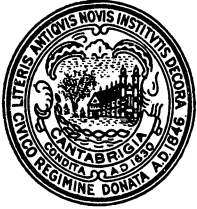

I request your authorization for transfer of funds within the City Infirmary budget appropriation codes.

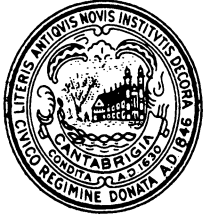
From: A-1 Permanent Salaries


